

Appalachian Trail head on Inn Road ([N40.38145](#), [W77.029375](#)):




Appalachian Trail access path near Watershed Road ([N40.382913, W77.033173](#)):



The Appalachian Trail takes 1 mile to climb 750 feet to the ridge of Cove Mountain. Just before you reach the top, the trail passes Hawk Rock which is one of the A.T.'s most scenic overlooks in Pennsylvania.
