Re: Duncannon Borough

The Penn Township Board of Supervisors recognizes the financial difficulties that the Borough of Duncannon is currently facing.

We have recently been made aware that the Early Intervention Program report presented in February to Borough Council contained recommendations to mitigate many of the Borough's challenges; one of which being the potential merger of our municipalities.

Although this potential action would directly affect the residents of the Township, as a board we have received neither official notification nor request for assistance of any type concerning this matter.

We respect and appreciate that Duncannon officials are facing a crossroads and many difficult decisions will need to be made within the Borough in the coming months. However, as a neighboring community, with limited to no official information, we also believe that this matter should be dealt with by the Borough without any outside interference or involvement on the part of Penn Township at this time.

Therefore, Penn Township has NO COMMENT to offer regarding the possibility of a merger or consolidation with Duncannon Borough
