4-Log Project, Sunshine Hill Water System

The Authority had voted previously to pay \$46,270.25 for the 4-Log project completed by DeTraglia Excavating, Inc. The check was signed tonight and will be picked up tomorrow by Mr. DeTraglia.

Old Business

Sunshine Hill Water System

Chairman Auxt reported that a representative from PA Rural Water would assist tomorrow in determining the location of the water leak on Sunshine Hill. An estimated 40,000 gallons per day is being lost and no one has yet been able to determine the cause. It was noted that the Borough had noticed an unusually high amount of water entering its sewer lines in the vicinity of Fritz Street. That water could possibly be coming from the eastern side of Eisenhower Boulevard, an area which will be checked.

Henry suggested that Chairman Auxt also contact L/B Water, Inc. as another resource. Additionally, Fluid Conservation Technology can provide assistance at the rate of \$146.00/hour, portal to portal. It was the consensus that Chairman Auxt should work with PA Rural Water and L/B Water, Inc. and keep the members updated. As a last resort, Fluid Conservation Technology will be utilized.

Adjournment

With all business completed, a Smart/Novinger motion for adjournment was made at 7:40 p.m. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
