The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday March 23, 2006 at 7:00PM in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Renner, Fred Hoffenbecker, Mike Freeman, Craig Raynor, Art Myers and Lee Bolan were in attendance. Susan Long as well as visitors Dave and Andrew Klinepeter also attended the meeting.

No meeting minutes were available for review. After a Hoffenbecker/Bolan motion and a 6-0 vote, the following invoices were approved for payment from the checking account: Dunc. Boro (electric) \$2.50, Smiths Farm \$99.80, Jim Renner (supplies) \$94.76, Maquires H/W \$36.94, Rettew \$48.28, Kevin Quirk (signs) \$1,398.00, Advance Publications \$4.00, Susan Long (supplies) \$31.78, Mike Freeman (supplies) \$41.17, Mutzabaughs Mkt \$58.09 and Home Depot \$127.70.

Susan Long presented a copy of PTPRB revenues and expenses for 2002 through 2005 and the budgeted amounts for 2006. In her Treasurer's report, \$2,000 was paid to Midstate Fencing from the budget account for the repairs to the backstop and other minor fence repairs around the park. The bank account balances were as follows:

Budget Account \$5,500.00 Newport Checking Account \$666.28 Newport Savings Account \$24,879.20

In his report to the supervisors, Jim reported that drainage work on the fields would be postponed until the Fall. In other business, Jim went over a number of items for old business: members taking ownership of various park projects or areas (ie sand in volleyball pit needs replaced, etc), provided an update on the barrel painting contest, discussed setting up a work party for work on the fields, provided an update on the outfield signs advertising, reported that a message center "case" had been ordered and reported on how work on the "Community Room" in the basement was progressing, (the boiler was removed).

In other business Andy Klinepeter presented his Eagle Scout project to the PTPRB. The project would involve the following items: replacing the stone steps up to the playground/pavilion area, installing a vine trellis over the steps, install a garden strip next to the steps. In addition to that project the PTPRB would look at working on the repairs for the previous Scout project: work on the wooden steps and shrubs, replace benches and re-landscape area.

There was no business. PTPRB members were reminded on when they needed to be at the Township building for the chicken barbeque on March 25, 2006. The meeting was adjourned at 9:00PM.
