The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday April 20, 2006 at 7:00PM in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Renner, Mike Freeman, Craig Raynor, and Lee Bolan were in attendance. Susan Long also attended the meeting. There were no visitors.

No meeting minutes were available for review. After a Raynor/Bolan motion and a 4-0 vote, the following invoices were approved for payment from the checking account: Dunc. Boro (electric) \$18.57, Jim Renner (supplies) \$58.58, Barricks H/W \$138.55, Maquires H/W \$82.55, Kevin Quirk (signs) \$135.00, Adv. Publications \$5.00, Mike Freeman (supplies) \$37.20, Morrison's (reimbursement) \$50.00 and Dunc. Youth Baseball (sign rev) \$720.00.

Susan Long her Treasurer's report for April. The bank account balances were as follows:

In old business, Jim reported that all of the work on the ball fields had been completed (fence repairs, dugout covers, weed prevention, etc) had been completed except for the drainage project, which would be delayed until the Fall. Jim reported that there had been no time to work on the horseshoe pits or volleyball court. In a related issue, Jim reported that he would look check on prices for a small rototiller for use in the park.

In the next order of business, the PTPRB members viewed the entries in the barrel painting project. The first place winner was Trudy Swope/Ellen Leach and second place went to Joel Hammaker. Gift certificates (1st-\$100, 2nd-\$50) from Barnes and Nobles were given to the winners. In a related item, the PTPRB decided to order lids for the garbage cans. Jim Renner reported that there was no action this past month on the Eagle Scout project or the Community Room. Susan Long presented a preliminary report on the chicken barbeque results. Revenues were \$2,254.00 and expenses were \$990.84 for a net profit of \$1,263.16.

In new business, Susan Long asked about someone power washing the picnic tables in preparation for people using the pavilion in the Spring. In other new business, Lee Bolan volunteered to take over the park's key inventory.

The next meeting was scheduled for Thursday, May 18, 2006. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30PM.
