The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday September 21, 2006 at 7:00PM in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Renner, Mike Freeman and Art Myers were in attendance. There were no visitors.

Meeting minutes for October/2005, February, March and April of 2006 were available for review. After a Myers/Freeman motion and a 3 to 0 vote the minutes were approved. After a Myers/Freeman motion and a 3 to 0 vote, the following invoices were approved for payment: Duncannon Electric \$42.16, Lowes \$19.97, Barrick's H/W \$16.38, Maquire's H/W \$23.99, Jim Renner (thatcher tines) \$18.00 and Moyer's (locks) \$12.50.

In the Treasurer's report for September, the bank account balances were as follows:

There were no visitors at the meeting. In old business, Jim reported that Adam was still getting his scout approvals for his Eagle Scout project. On the volleyball project, Jim reported that the net had been repaired and the sand had been replaced. Jim gave a brief update on the basement room. which still needs work. He was looking for some assistance with painting and some other preparation work. Next, there was discussion on the drainage issues for the ball fields. Finally, there was some additional discussion of the shed issue for the ball field, but it was reported that little has been heard from DAGSA on this topic lately.

In new business, the PTPRB briefly reviewed the budget for 2007 and equipment needs (new lawn tractor, other equipment, etc). In other new business, Jim reported that he was hoping to get some additional help for Nevin and the PTPRB for the 2007 season for various projects and work around the park. Jim also reported that he had sent a letter to the Penn Township Supervisors regarding the proposed Cove development. In other items, Jim reported that he had received a signed copy of the concession stand agreement from SASY and a copy of their insurance. Finally, Jim reported that the PTPRB had received a thank you letter and a donation of \$150 from Mutzabaugh's Market in appreciation for their company picnic, which they held at the park.

The next meeting was scheduled for Thursday, October 19, 2006. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00PM.
