

**Penn Township Park and Recreation Board**

The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday January 18, 2007 at 7:00PM in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Renner, Mike Freeman, Art Myers and Craig Raynor were in attendance. Keith Lindsay from Duncannon Youth Baseball was the only visitor in attendance.

No meeting minutes were available for review. After a Raynor/Freeman motion and a 4 to 0 vote, the following invoices were approved for payment:

In the Treasurer's report for December the bank account balances were as follows:

In discussion on field advertising, Jim stated that he was looking to contact additional organizations about advertising on the ball fields and was going to send out letters to potential advertisers. In discussion about the ball field conditions, Keith suggested contacting Martin's Limestone in Ephrata to check on costs quotes for Dymatex. In related business, it was reported that Bill Corsnitz was stepping down as President from DAGSA and that Bob Larish would become the new president. Mike Freeman reported that Jerry Rohrer had agreed to handle the field scheduling once again for the PTPRB.

In old business, there was some discussion on the Park and Recreation plan/report, and also on the proposed fee-in-lieu-of ordinance. Jim gave a brief report on the status of the Eagle Scout project.

In new business, after nominations and a 4-0 vote, Jim Renner was elected as President, Art Myers as Vice-President and Mike Freeman as Secretary. In a brief discussion about the Chicken BBQ, Mike stated that he would coordinate getting the ball teams help outside and would take care of ordering food and supplies.
