The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their scheduled meeting on Thursday March 22, 2007 at 8:00PM in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Renner, Mike Freeman, Art Myers and Fred Hoffenbecker were in attendance. Susan Long was also in attendance.

As the meeting was held after preparing the potatoes for the barbeque on Saturday, the agenda was rather brief and no meeting minutes were reviewed.

In reference to invoice payments, the PT supervisors agreed to refund the money back to the PTPRB budget account for the Rettew invoice (\$1,468.62) that was paid in early February. After a Renner/Freeman motion and a 4-0 vote, the invoices (\$39.78) were approved for payment.

In the Treasurer's report for February the bank account balances were as follows:

Budget: \$6,944.10 Newport Checking: \$624.7 Newport Savings: \$26,619.05

In old business on the chicken barbeque the inside work crew help was identified and Mike stated that he would be at park around 6:00AM to get things started up.

In new business, Jim discussed trying to get a work party organized for the following Friday (March 30), as DAGSA was looking to put their new shed up. Mike Freeman said that he would try to look into costs for dymatex for the ball fields. In other business, Jim presented his letter to Norfolk-Southern requesting permission for river access for recreation uses, requested permission to purchase a \$90 air compressor for the park, discussed a DCNR grant workshop for May 24th and presented the drafts of the DAGSA and DYB agreements/contracts. The board unanimously approved the purchase of the air compressor and for Jim to attend the grant workshop. The DAGSA and DYB agreements for the concession stand and field advertising for the 2007 season were also approved and signed.

The next meeting was scheduled for Thursday, April 19, 2007. The meeting was adjourned at 8:35PM.
