The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday April 19, 2007 at 7:00PM in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Renner, Craig Raynor and Mike Freeman were in attendance.

There were no visitors at the meeting. There were no minutes available for review.

In the Treasurer's report for April the bank account balances were as follows:

Budget Acct \$4,012.24 Newport Checking Acct \$625.07 Newport Savings Acct \$28,705.78

After a Raynor/Freeman motion and a 3 to 0 vote, the invoices (\$207.51) were approved for payment: Barrick's Hardware \$50.74, Cremo's (air compressor) \$99.00, Duncannon (electric) \$22.07, Maguire's Hardware \$14.98 and Smith Farm Equipment \$20.72

In old business, there was discussion on work needed on the ballfields and about getting diamond tex. Jim reported that he was abandoning his effort to turn the basement into a PTPRB office. In other business, Jim reported that he had garnered 9 new advertisers/signs for the ball field and that the available space on the small Penn Township field was sold out! The initial revenues and expenses for the barbeque only showed a profit of \$500+, but Freeman noted some revenues were still due from some individuals and groups. In final old business, Jim reported that he has sent his letter to Norfolk Southern to request right-of-way access to the river.

In new business, Jim suggested that we should look to set up a trail system to try to connect recreational facilities throughout the Township. Jim also discussed PTPRB members taking ownership in various projects or tasks around the park. Next, there was discussion on taking an inventory of the building/concession stand keys that the PTPRB had. In final new business, there was some discussion on the two vacant seats on the Rec board.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00PM. The next meeting is scheduled for May 19, 2007.
