The Perm Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday August 16, 2007 at 7:00PM in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Renner, Craig Raynor, Art Myers and Mike Freeman were in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM. No meeting minutes were available for review: There were no guests.

In the Treasurer's report for August the bank account balances were as follows:

The following invoices were approved for payment: (\$299.55): A.H.Rieff (stones) \$220.00,  
Barrick's Hardware \$40.15, Lowes \$32.41 and Maguire's Hardware \$6.99

In old business, Jim reported that the new John Deere tractor (model x500) had arrived! List price was \$5,599 but was only \$4,199.25 off of the PA State contract for a discount/savings of nearly \$1,400. On other old business, it was reported that SASY's, chicken bbq check was still outstanding. Mike reported talking to SASY at the beginning of August and their Treasurer was supposed to be sending us the payment. It was also reported that DAGSA had not turned in their \$1,000 payment for the concession stand yet. Jim would follow-up with Bob Larish. There was also discussion on getting concession keys back from DAGSA in case SASY was interested in running the concession stand again in the Fall (for a fee of \$50/month). There was no action on trails, dugouts or the soda machines. As for the picnic pavilion, the paint had been purchased and a work party was set up for August 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:00PM.

In new business, Jim presented a list of park goals for 2007/2008. (1) Sand/paint Twp building doors, (2) convert basement into useable space, (3) finish overlook project, (4) field drainage, (5) bike trail to PCRA par, (6) acquire land for parks, (7) repair BBQ pit, (8) paint picnic pavilion, (9) adult exercise trail, (10) lighting for basketball and/or volleyball courts. Jim suggested that project ownership was needed in order to complete these projects as he didn't have the time to pursue all of them himself.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55PM. The next meeting is scheduled for September 20, 2007.
