The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday April 17, 2008 ha the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Reamer, Craig Raynor0 Nancy Valdez and Mike Freeman Were in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10PM. No minutes were available for review. There were no visitors.

In the Treasurer's report for April 17th, the bank account balances were as follows:

In old business, the reports on "Think Spring" showed the following results: booth fees \$180.00, bird houses \$628.00 and initial BBQ profits were \$822.93 with some checks from SASY & DYB expected. In other old business, there was some discussion about the ball fields and some issues that DAGSA had with the fields. (They did some additional work on the fields on April 13th.) Several ideas were kicked around for uses for the basement room: various users' classes – i.e. arts, fatness, scrap-booking, etc. Discussion on the website was postponed as Dan Cooper was not in attendance. In regards to August 5th National Night Out handout, after a Freeman/Raynor motion, the board voted 4-0 to get key chains lights w/logos and 500 5.5" Frisbees.

In new business, there some discussion on panels for a skate park, grant writing and a new multi-governmental task force (Eastern Perry County Recreation Commission).

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00PM. The next meeting is scheduled for May 15, 2008.
