The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on April 16, 2009 in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Jim Remaer, Nancy Valdez, Art Myers and Mike Freeman were in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 7:20PM. No minutes were available. There were no visitors.

In the Treasurer's report for April 16th, the bank account balances were as follows:

Budget Acct: \$2451.65 Newport Checking Acct \$666.97 Newport Savings Acct \$13,915.96  
Newport CDs (4, 12 month for Jan, Feb, June & Aug @ \$5,000 each): \$21,172.98  
Marysville CDs (1, 12 month-March): \$5,000.00

The following invoices were scheduled to be paid at the supervisors meeting:

March (\$749.21): Rainbow Vision (class) \$340, Home Depot Cobq) \$237.68,  
Mike Freeman bbq supplies) \$171.53  
April (\$2,188.43): Mutzabaugh's Mkt (bbq) \$1,192.69, Dunc. Youth BB (sign rev) \$745.00, Lowes (supplies)  
\$102.16, Brown Printing (signs) \$90, misc \$58.58

In old business, Jim reported that a grant application for \$44,277 with DCNR for an exercise trail was prepared. Of the \$44,000 grant application, \$20,000 would be "free" and the remainder would be in "matching funds". Of the PTPRB's \$12,000 matching portion, most was planned to be provided thru use of Twp equipment, but approximately \$1,000 would come from 100 hours of volunteer labor.

In other old business, the board pursued purchasing four skate-park pieces that were authorized back in December. There was also discussion on ball field work needed, as well as potential project such as a golf tournament fund raiser or "3 on 3" basketball tournament.

In new business, the initial proceeds from the chicken BBQ only showed a \$400 profit, but funds were still due from DAGSA and Dune Youth Baseball. For equipment purchases, Jim discussed the need to get a "grader" for use on the ball fields and which would be helpful for work for the exercise trail. Approval to purchase the \$1600 grader was approved on a vote of 4-0. Also discussed was replacing the small bleachers in center field of the small field. Approval to purchase the \$1500 bleacher was approved on a vote of 4-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00PM. The next meeting is scheduled for May 21, 2009.
