The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their scheduled meeting on Thursday, March 29, 2012 in the Municipal Building. PTPRB members Karen Tilkens, Jim Renner, Betsy Kirkoff and Mike Freeman were in attendance. Penn Township supervisor, Brian Maguire also attended the meeting. There were no other visitors.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10PM. Jim Renner gave a brief update on the Spring Garden project. Jim would give the proposed "property use" agreement between Penn Township and Mutzabaugh's Markets to Stanley Mutzabaugh for his review. Jim also gave a brief update on park needs. He was going to check on trash can/barrel tops to see if any replacements were needed. Jim also reported that a new battery was needed for the Kabota lawn mower. The next agenda item discussed was National Night Out, which is scheduled for Tuesday, August 7th. There was discussion on either having a table in the square in Duncannon or having block party at the Penn Township Park. Additional discussion will be held at the next meeting before making a decision. For the next item, the PTPRB accepted Sean Beaver's letter of resignation from the PTPRB.
