

Penn Township Park and Recreation Board

The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday February 12, 2013, in the Municipal Building. All PTPRB members were in attendance. The following visitors attended the meeting: Ron Baker and Jason Ulrich – Duncannon Area Girls Softball (DAGSA) and Annette Mullen – The Pub Women’s softball team.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM. Ron Baker and Jason Ulrich represented DAGSA and requested field use for the 2013 season. They have scheduled week-end tournament dates on April 21st (opening day), May 10-12th and June 28-30th. They also requested use of the concession stand for 2013 under the recurring agreement with PTPRB, (\$1,000 rental for season). DAGSA also planned to have a field work day on April 6th and Jason agreed to act as the field scheduler/coordinator for PTPRB for the 2013 season. Annette Mullen represented The Pub Women’s softball team and requested use of the big field for practice and games. Mike Freeman represented Dellville Men’s Fastpitch team and also requested use of the big field for practice/games. Chicken BBQ tickets were given to each of the organizations, DASGA-200, Dellville-50, The Pub-30,

In old business, Karen and Jim reported that there were some additional discussions with the Penn Twp supervisors concerning the proposed new building/expansion of the existing concession stand/garage. Karen and Jim that explained that the PTPTRB had just started this process and that they would be doing additional research on pricing and funding (grants) before taking this to the supervisors.

As for the chicken bbq, which is scheduled for March 23, 2013, John reported that he had gotten some information from the Dunc Fire company concerning their portable bbq grill and had relayed that information over to Mike Freeman. Both John and Mike would be gathering checking on additional details in preparation for the bbq. In related business, Jim reported that he would be contacting the “rabies clinic” providers to let them know our bbq date this Spring.

There was also discussion concerning “fence-top cover” and “ball field barriers” for the park. Fence covers could prevent injuries along the low portions of the fencing and additional back-stop fencing and/or netting along the firstbase/right-field line could prevent issues with foul balls being hit down to the road and the properties next to the park. The PTPRB will look at several manufactures and BF Products for possible solutions and pricing to address these issues.

As for 2013 fund raisers, Jim reported that calendars were not done this year due to reduced success last year and because several other local groups had also begun selling calendars for fund raisers. As for a park “clean-up date”, Kids night out” and “Senior day out”, Karen said that she would do some further checking on these topics for the next meeting.

There was no new business brought up for discussion. The meeting was adjourned at 8:10PM. The next meeting is scheduled for March 21, 2013 at 7:00PM.
