The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Monday May 13, 2013, in the Municipal Building. Karen Tilkens, Jim Renner, Mike Freeman, Raymond Klinepeter and Karen Shields were in attendance. Fred Lauster (Dunc Park & Rec Board) and Paul Smith (Appalachian Trail Community) attended the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM. No meeting minutes were available for review.

Fred Lauster attended to invite the PTRPB to participate in National Night Out (Tuesday August 6th). Also, 2015 will be Duncannon's 150th anniversary with events the first week of August. Duncannon would also be holding a town-wide yard sale on June 1st in case Penn Twp wanted to participate. Paul Smith attended to discuss how the Appalachian Trail might be worked into recreation highlights on Penn Twp's website.

In the Treasurer's report, the bank account balances for May 13, 2013 were as follows:

In old business, the final results of the chicken BBQ were \$347 in profits. The PTPRB reaffirmed plans to sell the remaining wood charcoal to the Duncannon Fire Company. Kid's Night Out (movie/popcorn/pizza) is scheduled for Saturday June 22nd (6:00-9:00PM). Karen reported that the Senior Day Out (lunch) was another success with 23 attendees. The next Senior Day Out is scheduled for June 7th (first Friday of the month). The "Panning for Gold" event was scheduled for Saturday, June 1st (10:00-2:00PM) in Noye's Park in Duncannon as a joint PTPRB, Dunc Parks & Recreation and Appalachian Trail committee venture.

In other old business, Kim Miller tendered her resignation from the PTPRB. The PTPRB would not have anything at the Municipal Building for the primary election on May 21st as no one was available for that date. Karen Tilkens reported that she was still attempting to contact Apollo about installing the fencing and other work on the big ball field. The PTPRB discussed fees for events using the ball fields and separate resident (\$25) and non-resident (\$50) rates. The craft show was cancelled due to lack of interest. The PTPRB agreed to participate in National Night Out (August 6th) again, but volunteers would be needed for the event.

In new business, Jim stated that he'd like to see about establishing a handicap fishing zone/access area somewhere in the township. I stated that I would be on vacation and unavailable for the June 11th meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20PM. The next meeting is scheduled for June 11, 2013 at 7:00PM.
