The Penn Township Park and Recreation Board (PTPRB) met on Tuesday, July 14, 2015, at 7:15 p.m. in the Penn Township Municipal Building.

Present: Karen Tilkins, Ray Klinepeter, John Sproch, Jim Renner and Mike Freeman

Visitors –

Ron Baker and Jennifer Swails- DAGSA – Concession Stand – Ms. Tilkins offered that last year after the use of the concession stand was over there was a problem with the cleaning. She offered that it took her three days to clean up last year. During the inspections this year everything was going great until June when there was garbage left in the concession stand and grease everywhere and that the dishes were sitting out without being washed. It raised a big concern with the Township.

Ms. Swails offered that there are parents running the concession stand are told how to do the work. If a board member is here it is only because their child is here. There is an informal meeting to go over the coaches duties which include the concession stand. She offered that there could have been better communication between the parties. She continued that it is a feeling of being attacked for the last couple years. She also offered that there are problems with the stand itself.

When it rains the water makes the windows hard to manage and the counter top (outside) has come up. Last year there was a light issue that took months and that there is mold by the electric panel.

Ms. Swails offered that there is need to have a meeting to decide what is expected by both parties.

Mr. Baker offered that DAGSA works on the field, sells BBQ tickets. Mr. Baker asked if the concession stand is not used next year what type of donation would be expected.

Financial Report – The Financial Report was accepted upon a Tilkins/Renner motion.

Minutes – The June 9, 2015 minutes were accepted upon a Tilkins/Klinepeter motion.
