**Roadmaster Meeting**

Chairman Henry Holman, Jr. and Vice-Chairman Charles Stoner were in attendance. Other personnel present were Helen Klinepeter (Secretary), Alan Houck (Chief Houck) and Susan Long (Recording Secretary).

**RESIGNATION OF ROAD FOREMAN**

The Secretary presented a letter of resignation from Chris Deiter, effective March 30, 2007. Upon a Holman/Stoner motion, the PTS voted unanimously to accept the resignation of Chris Deiter, with regrets, effective March 30, 2007.

Upon a Holman/Stoner motion, the PTS voted unanimously to authorize the Secretary advertise for the position of highway worker.

**DUI TASK FORCE**

Chief Houck reported that the DUI Task Force is a cooperative effort between the state and local police and would be operated under the auspices of a grant received by Marysville Borough. He explained that Penn Township officers would be paid at the rate of \$20.00 per hour by the Township, but that Marysville Borough would reimburse the Township at the rate of \$30.00 per hour to compensate for use of vehicles, fuel, and payroll taxes.

Mr. Stoner stated that he is declining reimbursement for his Roadmaster duties.
