The Penn Township Board of Supervisors (PTS) met on Thursday, July 1, 2010 in the Municipal Building. Chairman Henry Holman, Jr. and Vice-Chairman CeCe Novinger were in attendance. Other personnel present were Helen Klinepeter (Secretary). A list of visitors is on file in the Township office.

Chairman Holman called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. with the *Pledge of Allegiance* and moment of silence. The Chairman reminded all present that the meeting was being taped to assist in the preparation of minutes, and anyone privately taping needed to declare that to all in attendance.

PENN TOWNSHIP/DUNCANNON BOROUGH RECYCLING PROGRAM

Mr. Holman offered that at the end of August 2010 Perry County recycling will no longer be funded by the County. Mr. Hammaker brought everyone up to date on the County's plan with buy a bag program. Boy Scout Troop would like to continue the recycling program.

The buy a bag program will be the County buys a bag for .25 cents and sells to the municipalities for \$2.50 and suggests that the municipalities sell the bags for \$2.75. Mr. Hammaker offered that he was informed that it would need 145 bags to cover a pull of a dumpster. A discussion commenced on the cost difference from the numbers given to what is said to be needed. Mr. Hammaker offered that a pull of a dumpster costs \$200. To try to save money, in July an exchange of the two 3 bay bins will be replaced with a 5 bay bin.

The cost of a year of recycling would be \$7,200 or \$3,600 for each municipality. Ms. Novinger asked has any other recyclers have been contacted? Mr. Hammaker offered that he has been in contact with Sylvester Services and Deimlers.

Mr. Hammaker offered that the containers may still be received from County and that he will get confirmation. If containers must be bought, they will cost \$8,000.00 each.

It was decided to let Mr. Hammaker try to get more information and if he finds a better offer, then he would contact the Secretary for another meeting before the Borough's meeting on July 20, 2010.

ADJOURNMENT

Upon a Novinger/Holman motion, the PTS voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 p.m.
