A committee meeting met to discuss the Recycling Program of Penn Township/Duncannon Borough on August 4, 2010 at 6:30 p.m.

PENN TOWNSHIP/DUNCANNON BOROUGH RECYCLING PROGRAM

Mr. Holman explained that the Borough, Township and Scouts have met before to discuss the recycling program and the best cost effective means to continue the program. He offered that Mr. Sharer requested to have a meeting with a Township Supervisor and to present his view of the process to date and that there were some misunderstandings. Mr. Holman turned the meeting over to the Mr. T. Hammaker. Mr. T. Hammaker reviewed his conversation with Mr. Sharer and the process up to this point.

Mr. Sharer stated that he was not told that there was competition for the pricing of the recycling program and that his price was the same as offered to the County. He also stated he did not remember agreeing the place three 5 cubic feet containers in July.

Mr. Sharer offered that he receives plastic up to number 6 and computers and that if we were not informed then County dropped the ball. Mr. Sharer also offered that he did not know if recyclables could be collected in a garbage truck. Mr. Sharer offered that he could collect recycling for \$380 a month.

Mr. Sylvester offered a list of items that would be received and that he knew recyclables could be collected in a garbage truck and that it would not be cost effective for him to transport recyclables to the dump. Mr. Sylvester offered that he gave his best price at \$400 a month and that he did not want to inter into a bidding war.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Holman thanked everyone for coming to the meeting and a decision would be reached by the Township at their meeting on August 5, 2010.
