**Minutes of June 25, 2014, Perry County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Hearing**

The Penn Township Board of Supervisors (PTS) met on Wednesday, June 25, 2014, at 7:00 PM in the Municipal Building to conduct a Hearing for the Perry County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. Chairman Henry Holman, Jr., Vice-Chairman Brian Maguire, and Supervisor Brian Peters were in attendance. Other personnel present were Helen Klinepeter (Secretary), Police Chief Richard Pickles, Solicitor Richard Wagner, Max Shradley (Engineer) and Elizabeth Goodhart (Treasurer/Recording Secretary). A list of visitors is on file in the Township office.

Chairman Holman convened the hearing at 7:00 PM, and turned the meeting over to Solicitor Wagner.

Solicitor Wagner explained that in 2000 the federal government passed the Disaster Mitigation Act which requires state and local governments to develop a mitigation plan to identify hazards as well as methods to reduce the potential loss to people and property as a result of those hazards. He stated municipalities are required to hold a public meeting to determine if the Township wants to follow the Multi-Hazard Plan adopted by Perry County or if they want to opt out of the County plan and develop their own plan. Solicitor Wagner stated the Township is required to conduct a Hearing to take testimony if anyone has a preference as to which plan to follow. Solicitor Wagner asked if there were any comments. None were made.

The Solicitor closed the record, and directed the Board to decide if they want to follow the plan adopted by Perry County or develop their own plan.

The Hearing was closed at 7:04 PM.
