MINUTES OF JUNE 25, 2008
Zoning Ordinance Amendment Hearing

The Penn Township Board of Supervisors (PTS) met on Wednesday, June 25 at 6:30 p.m. in the Municipal Building to conduct a Hearing to consider amendments to the Zoning Ordinance. Chairman Henry Holman, Jr., Vice-Chairman Randy Plummer, and Supervisor CeCe Novinger were in attendance. Other personnel present were Helen Klinepeter (Secretary), Susan Long (Treasurer), Rich Wagner (Solicitor) and Max Shradley (Engineer).

BACKGROUND

The Penn Township Planning Committee (PTPC) had recommended several changes to the Zoning Ordinance. These amendments require a public hearing in front of the Board of Supervisors, and approval of an ordinance containing the amendments. Changes were suggested for Article II – Definition; Article X – Mixed Use Commerce; Article XIII – Performance Standards; and Article XVI – Supplemental Use Standards.

ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT HEARING

Chairman Holman convened the hearing, announced that it was being recorded to aid in preparation of the minutes, and then turned it over to Solicitor Wagner.

The Solicitor verified with the Secretary that the hearing had been advertised and that the Proof of Publication contained a summary of the proposed revisions.

The Solicitor asked if there were comments from the audience and received none. He asked if any written comments had been received and was told there were none. The Solicitor asked if the Perry County Planning Commission had submitted any comments. The Engineer informed him that it had and the appropriate corrections and revisions had been incorporated by the PTPC into the proposed amendments.

ADJOURNMENT

Chairman Holman moved that, because there were no comments from the audience, the hearing be closed at 6:37 p.m. Mr. Plummer seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote of the PTS. No decision to approve or deny the proposed amendments was made.
